Alexandros G. Papadimitriou is a doctoral student in Philosophy of Law at the Law School of the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens (NKUA). His dissertation topic is “History and normativity in Montesquieu’s work”, supervised by the Emeritus Professor Konstantinos A. Papageorgiou.
